STATE OF INDIANA BURNS INDIANA 10-803 (2698). Tobacca nishing to minors-- It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to give, barter or sell, ectly or indirectly, to any child or children under 16 y ars any tobacco or prepara-tion of bacco, to be chewed or smoked by such child or children, whomsoever, with knowledge that it is to be chewed, or smoked by any child under the age aforesaid, or to persuade, advise, counsel or compel any child under said age to chew or smoke tobacco. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this section shall, on conviction, be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, and be imprisoned in the county jail or workhouse not less than ten days nor more than thirty

10-804 (2701). Cigarettes -- Minors not to buy, sell or use -- It shall be unlawful for any person under the full age of twentyone years, by himself or through any other person, or by any means, directly, or indirectly to buy, receive or accept for his own use or the use of any other person whatsoever, or to keep or own or to have in his possession, or to sell either as principal or agent, or to use any cigarette, cigarette paper, cigarette wrapper, or any paper wrapper containing morphine, r' tine, oil of hem, or any deleterious or poisonous ingredient or substance, ca

EDUCATION RELAT TO THE HARMFUL EFFECTS OF SMOKING

A report given at the eting of the Joint Committee on Health Problems in Education said there is a casual relationship between smoking and cancer, smoking and bronchitis, smoking and emphysema, and strong evidence of an association between smoking cardiovascular disease.

REGULATIONS ON STUDENT USE AND POSSESSION OF CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO PRODUCTS

The following regulations adopted by the School City of Gary insure continued enforcement and respect for the law and effective health practices:

1. No minor (person under 21 years) student shall bring, use or possess cigarettes or tobacco products at school or at school-sponsored activities, including athletic or musical events or on the school grounds.

2. The first violation shall be reported to the offender's parents or guardians.

3. Thereafter, violations will be reported to the Lake County Juvenile Court or the appropriate law enforcement body by referral through the School City's Department of Pupil Per-



An adult fairy story! That's just what it is! Animal Farm, by George Orwell, is certainly out of the ordinary. But George Orwell is known for the un-

The time of the story is not given, rather, it is left to the readers imagination. According to the descriptions of the farms, people, and habits, the time may easily be either the recent past or the present. The setting is Manor Farm, owned by Mr. Jones. The opening scene is one which is normal for an average day on the farm. After having had a hard day of labor, the animals suddenly decide that a revolution is in order. To the astonishment of the human beings, the revolution is a success, causing the name of Manor Farm to be changed to Animal Farm.

The remainder of Animal Farm is much like an ironic plot. resembling the workings of Socialism or Communism. The fact that George Orwell hated the Communists clearly shows through in his use of irony. If the reader closely studies Animal Farm, such figures as Marx, Lenin, Stalin, and Trotsky may easily replace many of the main characters.

Many people regard Animal Farm as a terrifying prediction of the future. The more one thinks about the possibility of such an experience, the more probable the occurance seems. Animal Farm may appear to be a fairy story, but the truth may be found after a closer
